Enrollment Specialist	 Indira Rios spoke to the current enrollment process and explained the lottery. teachers have been meeting students for re-enrollment we are a year round school with continuous enrollment, so all students must re-enroll the deadline for re-enrollment applications is June 12 if you want to start in July. This applies to students currently enrolled. Other students may also apply. The number of applicants should not exceed maximum capacity for each center. If we do exceed capacity, we will have a lottery June 16th Currently enrolled students will have preference in the lottery as well as siblings of the currently enrolled students. If students/parent cannot attend the lottery, they will be notified on June 18th The floor was open for questions Susana asked for clarification as to how parents will be notified. EL Master Plan Update	The Master Plan, last written in 2018, will be updated during the 2021-2022 school year. The Master Plan explains how our department functions and the "why" behind the structure of the ELD program. This next school year we will be adding two major things: The ELD Roadmap which is a self-reflection assessment. Teachers, administrators, and ELD Specialists look back at the school year and grade the program on a scale of 1-4 in a series of categories. These categories cover everything from our resources for our kids, needs of teachers, help for the student beyond graduation, etc. The Roadmap is new, did not exist in 2018. Thus it will be added to the plan. The World Languages Standards and Framework is also new. New way for schools to focus on maintaining a students home language and fostering it's growth alongside English. No questions were asked.
