Welcome/ Meeting Called to Order:	 Notes: Meeting starts at 5:05 pm Alison Mullins welcomes everyone and explains that this is an informal meeting and more of a parent information night about DELAC (District English Language Advisory Committee) Alison clarifies that DELAC is comprised of parents and staff members and its purpose is to advise the principals and teachers on best practices and policies for English learners Alison asks if anyone would like to request Spanish translation and Susana Guerra welcomes Spanish speaking guests in Spanish. No one indicates that they need translation.

DELAC Topics	 Approval of minutes from last DELAC meeting on May 27, 2021. Susana Guerra proposes approval of minutes and Janeatte McKee seconds. Alison reviews the definition of DELAC and its purpose. Alison reviews the responsibilities of DELAC committees as outlined by the CDE. Alison asks if anyone has questions about the specific responsibilities for DELAC. No questions are asked. Alison announces that ELPAC results from 2020 are available to students and parents in studenttrac. She walks through on screen how to access scores. Parents are also welcome to contact their student's EL Specialist to obtain scores and to explain what the results mean in terms of progress in English language proficiency. Susana addresses the students in the meeting and reminds them that ELPAC test performance is one of the things we work towards during EL appointments and that students who have passed it do not need to take it again. Alison introduces resources available (OFY D website). She shows how to view the website in different languages. She welcomes attendees to reach out with any questions they may have. 		

Announcements/ Programs and Services:	 Alison reviews announcements. She says that counselors will be contacting eligible students regarding AB104. Fall district assessment (Renstar) is coming up in September. Renstar scores inform our development of programs for English learners.
